May 1940: Men of the British Expeditionary Force (BEF) waded out to a destroyer during the evacuation from Dunkirk. On 10 May 1940, Hitler began his long-awaited offensive in the west by invading neutral Holland and Belgium and attacking northern France. Holland capitulated after only five days of fighting, and the Belgians surrendered on 28 May.
